Important Weigh-in Information

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 1ST

6:00am • Scales close at 9:00am

Males in Elements Ballroom • Females in Water Room

- All boxers are required to weigh-in and those boxing must have a physical today
- Weigh-ins and physicals take place by Region
- Only weigh-in staff and Regional Directors are allowed in the weigh-in rooms
- After each region has weighed in, their Regional Director will take the Master List to the office

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 2ND

6:00am • Scales close at 8:00am

Males in Elements Ballroom • Females in Water Room

- Only boxers scheduled to box today are required to weigh-in and have a physical
- Weigh-ins and physicals take place by Region

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 3RD

6:00am • Scales close at 8:00am

Males in Elements Ballroom • Females in Water Room

- All boxers in Championship Bouts are required to weigh-in and have a physical
- Weigh-ins and physicals take place by Region

PLEASE NOTE Per National Silver Gloves Rules

** NO CHANGES TO WEIGHT, NO EXCEPTIONS**

ALL boxers scheduled to weigh-in and have physicals MUST arrive at the assigned area by 6:00am. Participants arriving late will be DISQUALIFIED. NO EXCEPTIONS!

ALL boxers must make weight. Any participants exceeding their assigned weight limit will be DISQUALIFIED. NO EXCEPTIONS!

The official weigh-in scale is open one hour prior to the scheduled weigh-ins for trial weigh-in.



CONDUCT

Athlete Code of Conduct & Information

The Stoney Creek Hotel welcomes all athletes. We hope that the outcome of your competition is successful and fun. We also ask that while you are in our hotel you observe the following guidelines:

- All athletes have an 11:00pm curfew. Any athlete still in the tournament found breaking curfew will be DQ'd
 from the tournament and asked to leave.
- This is a smoke free facility. \$250+ fee for any violations.
- Any room damages and/or missing linens will be billed directly to your room.
- If you need something in the room during your stay, please contact the front desk.
- Do not take the towels or washcloths from your room.
- 14 years or older to use the exercise room.
- Breakfast is served Monday Saturday from 7am to 10am. Tickets for breakfast are issued at check-in.
 Otherwise, the discounted event cost is \$10 per person.
- Credit cards will be authorized for \$50 for incidentals.
- If any guests are compensated for noise due to your behavior, those charges will then be posted to your bill.

Spitting is permitted only in cups provided!

During the Bouts:

- Please note, there is a designated seating area for the tournament sponsor. No setting up camcorders in this area during the bouts. Anyone found sitting or filming in this area will be asked to move. (This includes blocking or standing in front of the area.)
